THE FIRST RECORD OF *DELPHACODES HAVANAE* IN THE UNITED STATES (HOMOPTERA: FULGOROIDEA: DELPHACIDAE)

Delphacodes havanae Muir and Giffard has been reported from Guyana, Guatemala, Cuba (Muir and Giffard, Bull. Hawaiian Sugar Pl. Assoc. 15:1-53, 1924) and Puerto Rico (Caldwell and Martorell, J. Agric. Univ. Puerto Rico 34:133-269, 1950).

I recently found one male specimen of this species among unidentified delphacids in the University of Missouri, Columbia, insect collection. The collecting data are as follows: Florida: Highlands Co., 2 Mi. So. of Childs, August 22-23, 1972, coll. J. E. Carrel, Light Trap Hatch 623.
